



Lifebuoy self-igniting light

A lifebuoy light is aimed at pointing out the position of a lifebuoy in the water. In case of an emergency situation of a man overboard, the lifebuoy will be thrown overboard together with the light to indicate the position of a person for the rescue team. It is activated automatically once it is thrown into the water by gravity sensor activation system when the lamp is pointed upwards.

Comply with Solas 74, LSA Code, 96/98/EC.

- Approximately 24 working hours at no less than 2 candela (standard required 2 hrs)
- Maximum drop height: 76 meters ;
- Working temperature: -30°C – +65°C;
- Expiry date: light body – 5 years;
- Battery should be replaced every year or after each use;
